**CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION TRANSMITTAL SHEET**

We wish to inform of the intent to allocate an additional \$13,541,023 in fiscal year 2004 Millennium Challenge Account (MCA) program funds to the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). Obligations will be incurred by USAID for assistance authorized by Section 616 of the Millennium Challenge Act of 2003 (the "Act") for the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) Threshold Program.

USAID will use the allocated funds to assist candidate countries that the MCC Board of Directors has determined demonstrate a significant commitment to improve their policy performance and potentially qualify as eligible countries under the Act. Assistance will be provided to help these countries improve their performance on the policy indicators that are central to eligibility. Pursuant to section 515 of Pub. L. 108-199, USAID will notify Congress of specific obligations, by country, incurred from this allocation. The attached notification is being sent to the Congress on February 16, 2007.

Allocation of such funds may be incurred fifteen days from the date of this notice.

In accordance with section 619(b) (2) of the Millennium Challenge Act of 2003 (the "Act"), this is to advise that the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) intends to allocate to the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) up to \$13,541,023 in FY 2004 MCA program funds, to administer the program authorized under Section 616 of the Act (the "Threshold Program"). Allocated funds will be obligated by USAID to assist selected "threshold" candidate countries to become eligible countries.
