In accordance with section 608(b)(1) of the Millennium Challenge Act of 2003 (the "Act" Pub. L. 108-199, Division D), the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) is submitting the enclosed report. On August 24, 2007, the list of candidate countries that are candidates for MCA assistance in FY2008 was transmitted to the appropriate Congressional committees. This report identifies the criteria and methodology that the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) intends to use to determine which of these candidate countries may be eligible to be considered for MCA assistance in FY2008.

As required by the Act, the information contained in this report will also be published in the Federal Register. Consistent with Section 608 (c)(1) of the Act, there will be a thirty (30) day period following publication in the Federal Register during which the public can provide comments regarding the selection criteria and methodology.

In accordance with Section 608 (c)(2) of the Act, MCC staff are available to meet with you to discuss the extent to which candidate countries meet the criteria contained in this report.
