On January 24, 2018, the Millennium Challenge Corporation (“MCC”) notified Congress of its intent to obligate up to \$2,600,000 under section 609(g) of the Millennium Challenge Act of 2003, as amended, for the purpose of facilitating the development of a Millennium Challenge Compact with the Government of Sri Lanka.

We now wish to advise that instead of using fiscal year 2018 funds, MCC intends to obligate, pursuant to section 7015(c) of the Department of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2017, up to \$2,600,000 under section 609(g) of the Millennium Challenge Act of 2003, as amended, for the purpose of facilitating the development and implementation of the proposed compact.

The funds are expected to finance activities necessary for MCC to assess the expected impact of the proposed compact, further design activities and develop implementation strategies.
