Eligibility Notification	
12-10-2014	At its quarterly meeting on Dec. 10, 2014, the Millennium Challenge Corporation Board of Directors votes to make Mongolia eligible for a compact.
Constraints Analysis	
09-02-2015	MCC and the Government of Mongolia complete an analysis of the constraints to economic growth in Mongolia. The analysis identified (i) a weak and unstable macroeconomic environment, (ii) inconsistent laws and policies, resulting in an unpredictable business environment, (iii) health impacts of air pollution in Ulaanbaatar, and (iv) costly access to water and sanitation in productive sectors and poor communities as binding constraints.
Eligibility Notification	
12-15-2015	At its quarterly meeting on December 15, 2015 the MCC Board reselects Mongolia to continue developing a new compact.
Concept Notes Received	
12-31-2015	The Government of Mongolia submits concept notes to MCC.

In addition, the analysis identified the effectiveness of government coordination as an overarching issue that directly impacts the binding constraints identified and the efforts of the GoM to address them to date. While the constraints analysis has yet to be formally published, there was agreement on the conclusions enabling MCC and GoM to move forward with project definition. The GoM completed complementary extensive initial social/gender and private sector reports informed by consultations.
